**WOW – Word on Wednesday**  
***Living Like He Lives!***

**Intro:** The most fundamental question in life is – Why Am I Here? Am I fulfilling God’s purposes for my life? The Bible is very clear on why we’re here and how we should live for God! We weren’t created by accident or by happenstance – we were created on purpose, for a purpose! We are called to live with intention - rooted in Jesus Christ, empowered by the Spirit, and aligned with His will for our lives.

**1. Living Like He Lives – Is to love God above everything else!**

- a. The two most important things God wants from you - to know Him and to love Him.
- b. God doesn’t want just to use you. He created you and saved you to have a loving relationship with you.
- c. To put God first means I choose my attitude, values, responses, and how I use my time with Him.

**2. Living Like He Lives – Is when you trust Him completely.**

- a. You trust God completely when you recognize that He knows what’s best for your life.
- b. When we rely on Him, we begin to trust God for the impossible.
- c. You and I serve a big God!
- d. We bring God pleasure when we take risks for Him in faith.

**3. Living Like He Lives – Is when you obey Him wholeheartedly.**

- a. Those who obey God’s Word truly show how completely they love Him.
- b. Obedience rooted in love is the requirement for ongoing, deepening fellowship with God.
- c. Don’t procrastinate: delayed obedience is disobedience.
  - Obey Completely – don’t pick and choose what to obey!
  - Obey joyfully – obedience isn’t easy, many times it’s inconvenient.
