| b. Rely on the Holy Spirit, true obedience is empowered by the Holy Spirit. | |
| c. Prioritize God over worldly influence, align your actions with God's Word. | |
| d. Aim to do what God says, when He says to do it, rather than partial or delayed obedience. | John 14:15 |
| e. Repent and realign when you fall short, confess and return back to God. | 1 John 1:9 |

3. See Jesus' glory through what He does (vs 9-11)
