The Sign of His Glory: Love in Motion

1. The Foundation: A Life of Perfect Obedience

- a. Jesus life was not a series of random events but a mission guided by faith and divine order. Romans 5:19
- b. Jesus life was rooted in the Father. John 14:23
- c. His public ministry began with the Father's declaration. Mark 1:11
- d. The Model of Humility: Though equal with God, He lived as a servant. Philippians 2:8
- e. Prioritize prayer and quiet moments with the Father over the spotlight of the crowd. John 4:48

2. The Ministry: Power Driven by Compassion

- a. The ministry of Jesus was defined by signs and wonders. His signs were a concrete expression of His message. 2 Thessalonians 2:9
- b. Love as the Engine: Jesus reasons for performing miracles was His deep compassion for the "unlovable." Mark 8:2
- c. The Breakthrough Jesus:
 - i. Every healing – the blind seeing, the lame walking, the dead raising was a foretaste of a coming kingdom.
- d. This is where brokenness and oppression are finally vanquished. Psalm 34:18
- e. He breaks racial barriers from broken lives. John 4:17-18

3. The Ultimate Expression: Sacrificial Love

- a. The love of Christ is the defining characteristic of His ministry and the standard for all who follow Him.
 - i. Love initiates: God demonstrated His love while we were still "rebels," sending His Son to the cross. Romans 5:8
 - ii. Love inspects: It's a radical standard - a "new commandment" (to love one another as He loved us!). 1 John 4:16
 - iii. The greatest sign of His love was the laying down of His life. John 3:16
 - 1. It was at the apex moment that He offered reconciliation and paying for our sins.

4. The Impact: The Transformation for Today's Troubles

- a. New Life Now – the Gospel offers freedom from internal prisons, shame, sadness, depression, and addictions.
- b. It transforms our "moral systems" and values. Ezekiel 36:26
- c. Jesus' life was the perfect example of love in action. Philippians 1:6
- d. He taught us that true greatness is found in service. Romans 12:10
- e. Let us move forward not relying on our own grit, but being controlled and energized by the love of Christ. Philippians 3:13
