The Sign of His Glory: The Greatest Promise of All

1. It's a Definite Promise ("And We Know")

- a. What you know is powerful and important. Daniel 3:17
- b. The word "Know" is used 1,019 times in the Bible. Psalm 27:3
- c. We don't have to guess about it, we know about it!
- d. We understand, we believe with certainty, we are persuaded, we are confident! Romans 8:38-39

2. It's a Divine Promise ("That God works")

- a. God is working on our behalf – God's work is not always evident immediately. Isaiah 64:4
- b. God is purposefully working on our every situation. Philippians 2:13
- c. He is orchestrating events for a greater purpose, even when His presence is not immediately visible. Proverbs 16:4
- d. Hidden provision is that God is always working behind the scenes through unexpected events. Psalm 138:8

3. It's a Definite Promise ("All Things")

- a. The promise allows for no more restrictions or limitations.
- b. The promise of God is "Yes and Amen".
- c. All means all, and that's all, that all means! Matthew 19:26
- d. This promise that we are investigating is not partial, it's not control by circumstances, it's not based on your goodness, but rather His goodness! Isaiah 40:28

4. It's a Dynamic Promise ("Together for good")

- a. Paul uses a Greek word "Sunergeo = Synergism" 1 Corinthians 3:9
- b. God is mixing all things together for the good.
- c. The promise that God works all things together for good doesn't mean that all things by themselves are good.
- d. Let's look at Joseph – throughout his life, Joseph trusted God no matter what, good or bad! Joseph experienced kidnapping, slavery, false accusations, wrongful imprisonment, rejection, and famine. Genesis 50:20
- e. But in the end, God brought things to a wonderful life-affirming conclusion. Proverbs 3:5

5. It's a Defined Promise ("To those who love God")

- a. This promise is an absolute promise, but it's not an absolute promise to everybody.
- b. This promise belongs to a certain group of people. Deuteronomy 7:6
- c. It's a fraternity for believers (those who love God). 1 Peter 2:9
- d. We love Him because He has called us out of darkness and despair. 2 Corinthians 6:16
