**VBS 2026 – Shine Brightly with Jesus**

***“There’s Nobody Like Him”***

***Responding to the Light***

***1 Kings 10:1-13***

**Intro:** Have you ever met someone who just left you in awe? I mean they were so awesome and wonderful that you were left shaking your head and saying, “There is nobody like that!” Well those kinds of meetings are rare, but they do happen occasionally. The Bible records for us the account of one such meeting. In this passage, the Queen of Sheba was left in amazement when she met King Solomon. She went away saying, “There’s nobody like him!” Many years later, when Jesus was ministering here on Earth, He mentioned this very event. He spoke of Solomon and the Queen of Sheba and reminded His listeners that He was greater than Solomon. “There’s nobody like Him!”

**I. The Reputation of the King**

a. She had heard of his wealth (vs 7)

1. She heard of great riches that flowed into the kingdom of Solomon.

1 Timothy 6:17-19

- *1 Kings 9:28- 31* 500 lbs. worth \$2,419,200,000
- *1 Kings 10:14-15* 500 lbs. worth \$38,361,600,000

2. Solomon’s wealth was greater than the imagination can comprehend!

b. She had heard of his works. (vs 6)

1. She had heard of the great kingdom he had built.

Proverbs 10:4

2. She had heard of the temple he had constructed for his God.

Proverbs 16:3

c. She had heard of his wisdom. (vs 1-3, 6-7)

1. He heard of his intellect and that he could answer deep questions.

1 Kings 4:29

James 3:17

James 1:5

2. She came because there were questions her god could not answer.

d. She had heard of his worship (vs 1)

1. Notice where the fame of Solomon was in the mind of this woman concerning the name of the Lord.

2. What impressed her more than his position, more than his power, more than his prosperity, and more than his prestige, was his worship and relationship with God.

3. She wanted to meet the God of Solomon.

## II. The Riches of this King

a. When the Queen of Sheba arrived at Jerusalem, she was astounded at the greatness of the King's wealth.

b. What she saw blew her mind.

1. She saw his possessions (vs 4, 13)

Philippians 4:19

2. She saw his provisions (vs 5)

Matthew 6:33

➤ She saw the meat (food) on his table, the massive amount to feed all who ate at his table.

3. She saw his people (vs 5)

Galatians 5:13

➤ She watched his servants as they ministered to him.

➤ She noticed how they sat in his presence listening to his voice.

## III. The Response to the King

a. Her personal discovery

1. Her trip to Jerusalem led her to some personal conclusions.

2. He was wealthier than she had heard.

3. He was wiser than she had heard. (He was able to answer all her riddles).

4. He was more wonderful than she had heard!
